We are a mainstream Chinese Medium-of-Instruction school.

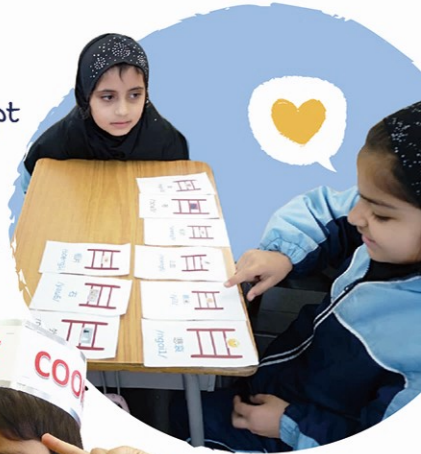
The number of NCS students accounts for about 20% of the total number of our students. Students of different nationalities can get on well with each other.

We employ extra Chinese teachers and NCS supporting staff to offer pull-out programme and professional support services for NCS students.



Chinese Curriculum & Language Policy

- All subjects are taught in Cantonese (except English and Putonghua).
- We guide NCS students to learn Chinese step by step and finally help them to transit into mainstream Chinese curriculum.



How do we help NCS students to learn Chinese?

- P.1 adaptation course for new P.1 students is provided.
- Small Class Pull-out Programme during Chinese lessons for P.1-3 NCS students is conducted. Teachers will use different strategies, e.g. provide picture guides etc., to cater for their learning needs. NCS supporting staff will also help NCS students learn Chinese during the Chinese lessons.



- Arrange free after-school Chinese enhancement course and homework support class for NCS students.
- NCS students are grouped into different classes and learn with the local students. With the language rich environment, they can learn Chinese better with the help of the peer learning and cooperative learning arrangements.

What are the support we offer to NCS parents?

- School circulars are issued in both English and Chinese versions.
- NCS Supporting staff are available to provide translation service and other supports for NCS parents (e.g. Urdu).
- Parents talks and workshops are provided.
