Students watch the video and try and catch all the words that have the target sound.







During face-to-face lessons, students learn through Total Physical Response (TPR), videos, songs, and phonics activities like the "Shapes" game. They practice listening for beginning, middle or end sounds with the "Smack the board" game. Pupils also have iPad activities and worksheets to consolidate learning. At the end of the lessons, Ms. Suzan gives out Golden Tickets and Prizes to four star students!

Zoom lessons are kept interactive so that children stay focused, engaged, and interested in the topic. Online lessons have a variety of components including video and phonics activities on Kahoot!, Wordwall, and Quizziz.


### Drama Festival

50 students from P.1 to P.3 had the opportunity to join the Japan and Australia Virtual Tours run by the English Wise Learning Centre on 27th July, 2022.

Students were very excited and fully involved in the tours. Both tours widened their horizons in learning English as well as in exploring the outside world.

During the tours, students interacted with the Native English teacher and read and answered information and questions in English confidently.

The online tour started at 9:00 a.m. Students followed the itinerary, and virtually toured various attractions including religious and historical landmarks in Singapore.




The tour was followed by an online (Zoom) STEM Workshop. The Flight Simulator Workshop was designed to encourage interest in aviation.

Place: Merlion Park

Caption: The Merlion was first designed for Singapore in 1964—the lion head with a fish body quickly became Singapore's icon. The Merlion is 8.6 cm high, and weighs 70 tons. That's amazing!

Place: Gardens by the Bay

Caption: Gardens by the Bay must be the most scenic place in Singapore. You can walk along the high road. It sounds dangerous, so be careful while walking. Gardens by the Bay has ten towns. When it is night time, all the towns light up and get bright. This may be a good time to take a photo!

presents to Santa Claus!


The letters would in fact be delivered via a postal service, Santa Claus' Postal Express, direct to a real address... all the way in Finland!




